Small Price for the Biggest Ship Based in Australia This Summer

**20-night luxury cruise from Australia to Asia
and two nights in Bangkok's tallest hotel
plus flight home from \$3159**

The biggest cruise ship based in Australia this summer and Thailand's tallest hotel form part of a bargain package Cruise Express is offering next February.

The 22-night fly/cruise deal includes a 20-night voyage aboard the huge Diamond Princess from Sydney to Bangkok on February 21, 2010, two nights with breakfast in the 88-storey Baiyoke Sky Hotel – Bangkok's highest hotel – and a Qantas flight home to Australia and is priced from \$3159 per person, twin-share, from **Sydney, Melbourne and Perth** and from \$3293 from **Adelaide and Brisbane**. *

The voyage from Sydney to Bangkok includes half a lap around Australia with visits to Melbourne, Hobart, Adelaide, Perth and Exmouth as well as calls to Ho Chi Minh City in Vietnam and Sihanoukville in Cambodia where an extended tour will be available to the world's largest temple at Angkor Wat.

The 2670-passenger Diamond Princess will be the biggest cruise ship based in Australia this summer and second only to Queen Mary 2 as the largest liner ever to visit Australia.

A destination in herself, the 18-deck Diamond Princess offers six restaurants, five main lounges, five pools, eight jacuzzis, a wedding chapel, ship-top nightclub and observation lounge, 1340 cabins - including 750 with private balconies - and a wrap-around outside promenade deck that takes passengers to the very tip of the bow where they can play 'King of the World'.
