New Discount Fly/Cruise Packages for Over 50s Aboard one of the World's Last Traditional Liners *Saga Ruby*

A former Cunard liner, the mid-sized, 650-passenger Saga Ruby caters only for passengers over 50 and offers classic British cruising touches such as dance hosts for single female passengers, cabins for solo travelers, cabin portholes instead of windows or balconies, traditional afternoon teas, the sounding of ship's bell at noon, the hosting of dining tables by senior officers, expansive teak decks, an indoor and outdoor pool, a deep draft for smooth sailing and the sleek, rounded profile of a traditional liner.

Described by the 'Bible of cruising', the Berlitz Guide to Cruise Ships, as gracious, refined, civilised and friendly, the 24,500-ton Saga Ruby will visit Australia next March as part of her 2010 world voyage.

Cruise Express has two fly, cruise and stay packages for passengers over 50 on cruises to and from Australia:

- A 13-night package including an Air New Zealand flight from Australia to Auckland on February 19, 2010, two nights in Auckland's Stamford Plaza Hotel with breakfast, transfers in Auckland and an 11-night cruise on Saga Ruby from Auckland on February 21 to Sydney via Tauranga, Napier, Wellington, Christchurch, Dunedin and Hobart.
Priced from only \$2820 from **Sydney**, \$2850 from **Brisbane**, \$2826 from **Melbourne**, \$2898 from **Adelaide** and \$3112 from **Perth**. Fares are per person, twin-share.
- A 14-night package including a 12-night voyage on Saga Ruby from Sydney to Bali on March 5, 2010, two nights at Bali's Nusa Dua Beach Resort with breakfast, transfers in Bali and a flight from Bali back to Brisbane or Sydney with Jetstar.
Priced from \$3015 per person for **Brisbane** passengers and from \$3165 for **Sydney** passengers.
