03 JUNE 2010 – STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN

Half day tour

Explore Stockholm by private air-conditioned coach for a guided, half day sightseeing tour. Visit the City (Nobel Prize) Hall and Royal Palace, walk through Gamla Stan (the Old Town) and visit the unique Vasa Ship Museum.

04 JUNE 2010 – HELSINKI, FINLAND

Half day tour

Enjoy a guided morning sightseeing tour of Helsinki by private air-conditioned coach. View Parliament Square and the Sibelius Monument and visit the impressive Temppeliaukio Church (the Rock Church).

05 JUNE 2010 – ST PETERSBURG, RUSSIA

Full day tour

Today's tour will start with a city orientation drive, before visiting the Imperial Summer residence, Catherine's Palace at Pushkin. See the palace, walk through the marvellous park nearby and enjoy lunch at the Summer Palace Restaurant. Take a Metro ride to see the incredibly beautiful underground railway stations before transferring to our private air-conditioned coach to visit Petrodvorets (Peterhof) Grand Palace and water gardens.

06 JUNE 2010 – ST PETERSBURG, RUSSIA

Full day tour

A second full day sightseeing tour will include a visit to Peter- and-Paul Fortress. Enjoy a boat trip through the canals of St Petersburg, the "Venice of the North". Visit St Isaac's Cathedral and, time permitting, there will also be an opportunity to shop at the local markets before lunch at a local restaurant. This afternoon visit the world famous Hermitage Museum.

07 JUNE 2010 – TALLINN, ESTONIA

Half day tour

Our guided morning tour of beautiful Tallinn, mainly on foot, will visit the Dome Church and Alexander Nevsky Cathedral. Enjoy some time at leisure exploring the old town square before transferring back to the ship.

08 JUNE 2010 – GDANSK, POLAND

Half day tour

This historic city together with Sopot and Gdynia is the most important cultural, economical and academic centre of Northern Poland. For connoisseurs of culture and art, Gdańsk has many historic buildings and monuments to offer, including St. Mary's Church, one of the largest brick churches in the world and famous for its astronomical clock.

Half day tour

There is also the richly adorned 17th century Golden Gate, the late-gothic Artus Court that stands on the Main Town's old "market square" called the Long Market and crowned by the 16th century Green Gate, the Crane, the oldest existing port crane in Europe, and many other interesting sites.

10 JUNE 2008 – OSLO, NORWAY

Half day tour

Today our guided morning sightseeing tour will view the City Hall, Norwegian Parliament Building and the Royal Palace and visit Frogner Park, also known as Vigeland Sculpture Park.
